NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENT

The following notes follow the numbering in the accounts:

- 1. The Precept payment was larger than expected.
- 2. Concurrent Functions are included in the Precept payment
- 3. Interest: Deposit Account: £9.42 Pension Account £0..25
- 4. VAT has not yet been claimed. This is in hand.
- 5. No budget provision was made for the pension fund in this year.
- 6. There is no income for capital projects in this year's budget. Payments are being made against money received in the previous year.
- 7. Donation £436 received from the War Memorials Trust
- 8. Salaries are higher as the Council agreed an increase in hours from 20 to 30 per month. Clerk's salary £3174.68, PAYE £858.96
- 9. Administration costs have been met from Petty Cash, being principally stamps and stationery. The amount shown is for refurbishment of the Chairman's chain of office. £77.61, £30 to St. Oswald's Church Oswestry for printing the community surveys and £100 to Llanymynech Youth Club for distribution of the surveys.
- 10. The pension fund was credited for the year and after 31st March
- 11. SLCC £77; One Voice Wales £88
- 12. The apparent overspending results from the payment of £9,954.00 for Phase 2 of the Border Gateway Project from funds paid to the Council in 2014/2015.
- 13. Donation to Llanymynech youth Club £550; Llanymynech Parish Council (Maintenance of Clock) £196.80; Good Companions Club £300
- 14. Rents: Powys County Council (Walls Bridge) £50; Village Hall (Council meetings) £136. The overspending on the Village Hall rent was as a result of hiring the hall for a meeting of the N. E. Montgomeryshire Cluster Group.
- 15. No travel budget was set in this year. However expenditure was agreed for the Clerk for travel to meetings and courses over the year.
